









FIVEFOLD VENN DIAGRAM






EPHESIANS 4 IN THREE DIMENSIONS


STAGES OF DEVELOPING A DISCIPLESHIP CORE

ACTS	ICON	SUMMARY OF THE SIX ACTS OF GOD'S STORY
Creation		God creates the heavens and the earth and charges people made in his image to tend to creation and create culture.
Fall		People turn against God and the rebellion rips through all creation, personally, socially, and cosmically, creating a world of brokenness, sickness, decay and death.
Israel		In a surprising response to the rebellion, God chooses to redeem the world by forming a nation to be a sign pointing to shalom, a foretaste embodying his presence, and an instrument bringing his justice and peace, seeking to bless all nations.
Jesus		Amidst the rise and fall of Israel, God becomes flesh as Jesus of Nazareth, the ultimate sign, foretaste and instrument of God's Kingdom, displayed through his life, death and resurrection.
Church		After Jesus' ascension into heaven, his followers are co-missioned to carry on his work of being a sign, foretaste and instrument through the indwelling of his Spirit as they continue to look ahead to his glorious return.
New Creation		At his appointed time, God makes his permanent home on earth, and Jesus' reign is consummated. The long-awaited renewal of creation takes place, bringing total justice, peace and life.


PEOPLE GIFT	ENVIRONMENT	DESCRIPTION
Apostle	Thriving	Helping the community step out into new territory, living out their "sentness" in their neighborhood and networks by multiplying disciples, ministries and missional communities
Prophet	Liberating	Helping the group pursue God, experience liberation from personal and social sins, as well as stand with the poor and oppressed in the power of the Spirit
Evangelist	Welcoming	Helping the community extend the table of fellowship to all, especially those whom society has marginalized, by being witnesses of His great love.
Pastor	Healing	Helping people embody reconciliation as well as work through their past hurts and move toward a sense of wholeness in the context of community.
Teacher	Learning	Helping the community inhabit God's story in such a way where the community teaches one another what it means to live into God's future in an everyday kind of way.






